



To be considered complete, your application must include the following:

- Application for Admission
- \$75.00 application fee
- official transcripts from all colleges/universities attended sent directly to MiSPP admissions
- current resume
- two current professional and/or academic recommendations (list on application)
- PsyD Applicants** - official GRE general test score report (school code: 1413)
- essay/personal statement addressing the following (2-3 pages):
  1. An autobiographical account tracking the development of your interest in psychology (include relevant work experience), your reasons for selecting MiSPP, and why you are a good match for our program.
  2. Self-directed learning and personal growth are emphasized at MiSPP. Comment on your readiness for this orientation, including examples of self-directed learning and personal growth endeavors.
  3. The strengths you would bring to this program and the areas in which you would like to increase your knowledge and skills, including short- and long-term goals.

The application review process focuses on educational performance, letters of recommendation, relevant experiences, and the professional presentation of self in the application essays. Upon review, you may be invited for an interview. Upon completion of the interview, the Admissions Committee will make a decision regarding program admittance.

Additional required documents for International (F1) applicants:

- an official course by course evaluation from ECE or WES sent directly to MiSPP
- official TOEFL score report sent directly to MiSPP
- international student forms with all supporting documents (available at [mispp.edu/admissions](http://mispp.edu/admissions))
